**CWA Joe Beirne Foundation Scholarships
2010 - 2011 School Years**

CWA Headquarters in Washington has announced the Joe Beirne Foundation's annual scholarship offerings for 2010 - 2011 school years and will be taking applications on-line only.

Those eligible for the scholarships are CWA members and their spouses, children and grandchildren, including the dependents of retired, laid-off or deceased members. Applicants must be high school graduates or high school students who will graduate during the year in which they apply. Undergraduate and graduate students returning to school may also apply.

The Foundation's Board of Directors has approved the awarding of Fifteen (15) partial college scholarships of \$3,000 each are being offered for the 2010-2011 school year. Winners, selected in a lottery drawing, also will receive second-year scholarships of the same amount contingent upon satisfactory academic accomplishment. Part-time students, less than 12 credits, will receive half of the scholarship monies. Winners are selected in a lottery drawing.


PLEASE NOTE that applications will be taken solely online by filling out and submitting an online application form and an essay at the Foundation's website:
